

Glock Extended Mag Release:
Small frame (9mm and .40) and
Large frame (10mm and .45) Glock pistols

Parts Included:

- Mag button frame
- Button
- One (1) 4-40 x 3/8" flat head cap screw

Installation Instructions

CAUTION: REMOVE MAGAZINE AND VISUALLY CHECK CHAMBER TO MAKE SURE THAT FIREARM IS UNLOADED.

Using the blade of a small screwdriver, capture the mag release spring and pull it out of the mag release, being careful not to damage the mag release channel. The original mag release will slide out of the frame. Insert the drilled and tapped mag release provided with the extended button and insert it into the frame. Reengage the spring and install the mag button on the mag catch using a thread locker on the screw.
